Walnut Grove Fine Arts Association Announces Sean Logan, Artist for the Visually Impaired

April 10, 2007 (Eureka, Illinois) – The Walnut Grove Fine Arts Association announces Sean Logan, artist, who will have an art exhibit for the visually impaired in the Eureka College Cerf Center at the 5th annual Eureka Lilac Festival and Fine Arts Fair on Saturday, April 21, 2007, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the campus of Eureka College.

The painting he is bringing to the festival is entitled, “Sunset for the Sighted, Sunrise for the Blind”. The intent of his work is to bring the visually impaired into an audience for an artistic medium that typically ignores the group.

Each individual color zone of the painting will have a slightly different temperature than the neighboring area of color. The differences in temperature allow for the audience to lightly brush their hands across the surface of the painting to “see” the color of the painting.

“Sunset for the Sighted, Sunrise for the Blind” will teach color to those that cannot see with their eyes but Logan wishes the concept to be much more. It is his hope that someday artisans and educators join together with those of other influence in the community. All together “we may become what is the greatest gathering of philanthropy in the world. Education, enlightenment, entertainment, and support are all goals of creating a Sunrise for the Blind” said Logan.
